Resolution in Support of Tiffany Sports Lounge’s Application to Waive the 45 Day Waiting Period for a Pull Tab License

WHEREAS, Walmart Inc, doing business as Tiffany Sports Lounge has been doing business in Highland Park for 46 years; and

WHEREAS, the Highland District Council’s Community Development Committee met with Mike Pickett, Community Relations for St. Paul Serves Foundation, on February 15, 2018 to discuss the proposed addition of a charitable gaming/pull tabs license at Tiffany Sports Lounge, and the waiver of the 45 day wait period of that license ; and

WHEREAS, St Paul Serves Foundation has operated pull tabs in four other local establishments for some time; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Highland District Council supports the waiver of the 45 day wait period of a charitable gaming/ pull tab license for Tiffany Sports Lounge, the establishment at 2051 Ford Pkwy.
