Resolution Asking the City of St Paul Public Works to Re-Stripe MRB

WHEREAS, a neighbor attended the Highland District Council's Transportation Committee meeting on April 11th to discuss the concerns of speeding, large volume of traffic, and cars passing on the Mississippi River Blvd, which has a 25 mph speed limit, and

WHEREAS, the Committee discussed options for calming traffic, such as re-striping with double yellow lines, installing a digital display and increasing enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the amount of traffic will only increase with the development of the Ford site; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Highland District Council's Board asks the City of St Paul's Public Works Department to re-stripe the Mississippi River Blvd from Magoffin Ave to Prior utilizing the 12 inch double stripes to help calm traffic and improve overall safety for cars, bikes and pedestrians.
