### **Resolution for Improvements to Hamline Ave**

Whereas, multiple neighbors have brought to the attention of the Transportation Committee of the Highland District Council, that crossing at Hamline Ave and Randolph Ave by the Nook, and other businesses, has become more difficult for both drivers and pedestrians; and

Whereas, with cars parking on the west side of Hamline directly up to the crosswalk at Hamline and Randolph, that drivers are not able to adjust quick enough to people getting out of their cars or crossing the street; and

Whereas, in the evening, or after dark, the lighting in this section of Hamline does not provide adequate lighting; and

Whereas, the Highland District Council has worked with Cretin-Derham Hall, EXPO, and Holy Spirit Schools on a Safe Routes to School plan; and

WHEREAS curb extensions and a continental striped crosswalk on the north side of Hartford and Hamline are one of the last recommended improvements for the SRTS plan; and

WHREAS the Niles and Juno intersections on Hamline are directly across from a school and business area; therefore

Be it resolved, that the Highland District Council requests that the City of Saint Paul install an overhead light to an existing pole on Hamline near the Nook, install a No Parking sign on the west side of Hamline on an existing pole to mark the 30' distance from the south crosswalk at Hamline and Randolph, install curb extensions on the north corners of Hamline and Hartford, and continental style painted crosswalks at Hartford, Niles and Juno during the upcoming mill and overlay in 2020, to facilitate safer pedestrian crossing.
