Please note these are <u>planned</u> activities and will vary based on various scheduling factors, inclusive of weather. We will strive to communicate the most accurate information available in projecting our work plans. The presence of construction vehicles, equipment, and delivery trucks means that we can expect congestion in the area surrounding the project.

- Due to the Highland Fest, <u>we will not be working this weekend</u>. Also, we expect much more vehicle and pedestrian traffic than usual over the weekend. We urge everyone to take care and follow the routes as marked by the construction safety signs, especially along Highland Parkway where the sidewalk and partial lane closure will remain in place.
- No additional closures or obstructions are scheduled for the coming week.
- Wall panel deliveries are complete, but trucks will be delivering lumber.
- Crane will be operating all week. When not in operation, as a safety requirement, the crane is supposed to swing to adjust
 for the direction of the wind (called "weathervaning"). However, when operating, the crane will not be swinging any loads
 over adjacent properties. Could possibly be gone by the end of the week.
- Streets will continue to be swept at the end of each work day that vehicles exit the site.
