Our primary goal for the meeting was to take the information from the survey results compiled at the last meeting and formalize them into Goals and Strategies. The five goals are:

- **Improve Pedestrian Safety and Accessibility**
- **Increase Bicycle accessibility**
- **Expand and Encourage the use of Transit**
- **Maintain Safe and High-Quality Infrastructure**
- **Manage the flow of vehicles and parking accessibility**

For each of the goals there are strategies that support accomplishing the goal. We worked through the 1st goal and started the 2nd at the meeting using the survey feedback summary

- **Improve Pedestrian Safety and Accessibility**
 - o "Pedestrian First" in all planning
 - o Expand Pedestrian Safety Infrastructure
 - o Engineer Streets for safe speeds and walkability
 - o Complete sidewalk grid/system where possible
 - o Support accessibility features for everyone
 - o Support "safe routes to Schools" program
- **Increase Bicycle accessibility**
 - o Supports the city bike plan
 - o Encourage safe biker/pedestrian Integration
- **Expand and Encourage the use of Transit**
- **Maintain Safe and High-Quality Infrastructure**
- **Manage the flow of vehicles and parking accessibility**

Question: Does what we have so far meet the requested format? Should we elaborate on the strategies more? It's easy to get too wordy but just want to make sure the strategy provides enough direction to meet the Goal.
